### Summer Sermon Series: Travel Adventures from the Bible

As we head into the summer months, it's often the case that we find ourselves travelling to one place or the other for rest, recreation and sometimes, even business. Our travels can be rather unremarkable, but most of us have had travel experiences that transformed and changed us in some way. Can you think of a trip like that? In our summer sermon series this year, we'll be looking at some Bible stories involving both travel and transformation.

**TODAY** - Genesis 37:12-28. Joseph had a problem with his brothers, and their resentment led them to betray him and arrange for him to be sold into slavery in Egypt. As it turns out, their betrayal was the beginning of a marvelous story illustrating God's faithfulness even in the darkest of times. Sometimes a terrible, awful, hurtful trip can yield an amazing blessing.

**Next week** - Acts 8:26-40. On his way home after a trip to Jerusalem to worship at the temple, an Ethiopian eunuch is mystified by what he reads in the Hebrew Scriptures. A disciple by the name of Philip is sent by God to teach this man, and consequently his life is changed forever. Sometimes a trip that seems to be ending in confusion can unexpectedly yield great insight and meaning.
