Summer Sermon Series: Travel Adventures from the Bible

As we head into the summer months, it's often the case that we find ourselves travelling to one place or the other for rest, recreation and sometimes, even business. Our travels can be rather unremarkable, but most of us have had travel experiences that transformed and changed us in some way. Can you think of a trip like that? In our summer sermon series this year, we'll be looking at some Bible stories involving both travel and transformation.

TODAY - Luke 24:13-35. The disciples walking towards the small village of Emmaus in the days after the resurrection were actively discussing the events that had transpired in Jerusalem and had many questions with few answers. On the way they encountered Jesus, who was made known to them in the breaking of the bread. Sometimes the significance of a trip is not so much the journey itself but on whom we encounter along the way.

Next week - Genesis 37:12-28. Joseph had a problem with his brothers, and their resentment led them to betray him and arrange for him to be sold into slavery in Egypt. As it turns out, their betrayal was the beginning of a marvelous story illustrating God's faithfulness even in the darkest of times. Sometimes a terrible, awful, hurtful trip can yield an amazing blessing.
