- ***DO** adhere to the items on the shopping list.
- ***DO** place all items in a 16x12x12 inch box (found at Home Depot or Lowes as a "small moving box").
- ***DO** be creative and decorate with crayons, markers and stickers!
- ***DON'T** put perishable items of any kind in your box (produce can be donated during the listed produce drop-off times below).
- ***DON'T** include glass jars, candy or toys in your box.
- ***DON'T** overfill your box. It must be able to close so that it can be stacked.
- ***DON'T** seal the box closed.
